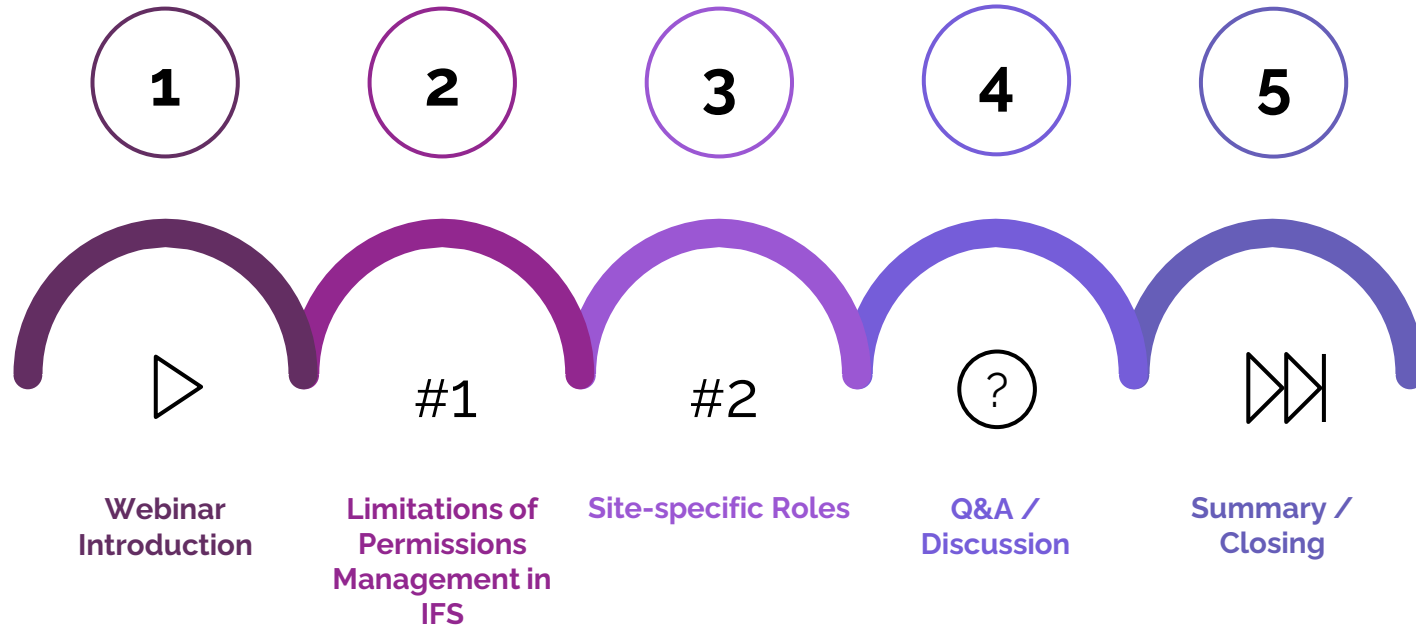

# Limitations of Permissions Management in IFS

## Limitation #1

No official methodology

- flexible permission sets
- no recommended structure or best practices
- Every customer must define their own approach

## Solutions/Workarounds

- Decide: develop a concept / structure internally or seek external expertise
- KISS principle:
  - role-based structure
  - avoid deep hierarchies
  - manageable number of end-user roles
- More details in a later webinar

## Limitation #2

No standard roles or templates

- There are some predefined technical roles
- But there are no process-based templates
- Roles must be built from scratch

## Solutions/Workarounds

- Decide: develop a roles internally or seek external expertise
- KISS principle:
  - role-based structure
  - avoid deep hierarchies
  - manageable number of end-user roles
- More details in a later webinar

## Limitation #3

Limited consulting support

- IFS and its partners typically do not offer non-technical consulting for permissions — though this might differ from one region to another
- Customers must either build expertise in-house or find external consulting support

## Solutions/Workarounds

- Decide early: manage permissions internally or work with non-IFS consultants
- If managing internally:
  - dedicate enough resources — especially critical during implementation and upgrades
  - network with other IFS customers to exchange insights and best practices

## Limitation #4

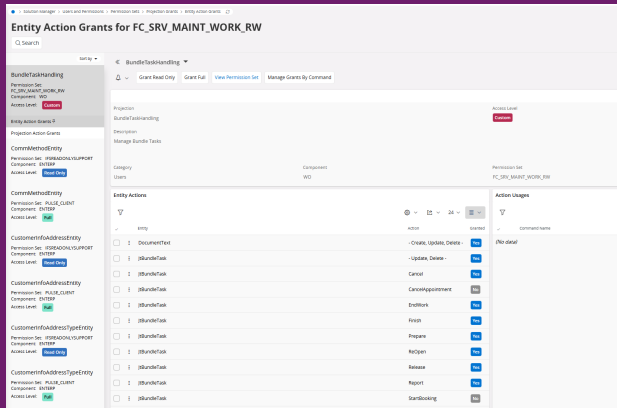
IFS updates disrupt permission sets

- Updates can change projection structures
- Example: A "read-only" projection changes to "custom"
- Indication that something has changed, usually requires manual review and adjustments

## Solutions/Workarounds

- Use clear naming conventions and documentation
- E.g. the name "Purchase Order Read & Write" along with a clear documentation that tells you what is granted with which access level
- This lets you know what to adjust after an update

## Limitation #5

Missing projections in "Manage by Navigator"

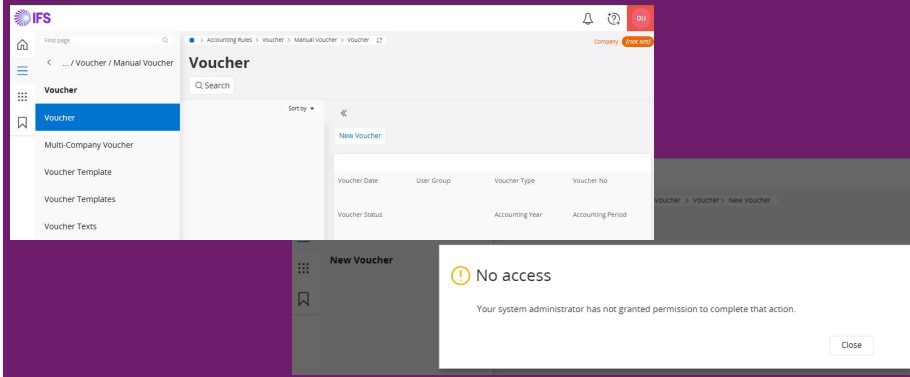
- Some projections are not visible in the Navigator
- Accessible only via specific URLs or by navigating through multiple pages
- Permission sets could miss key projections
- Often found only after extensive testing or live usage

## Solutions/Workarounds

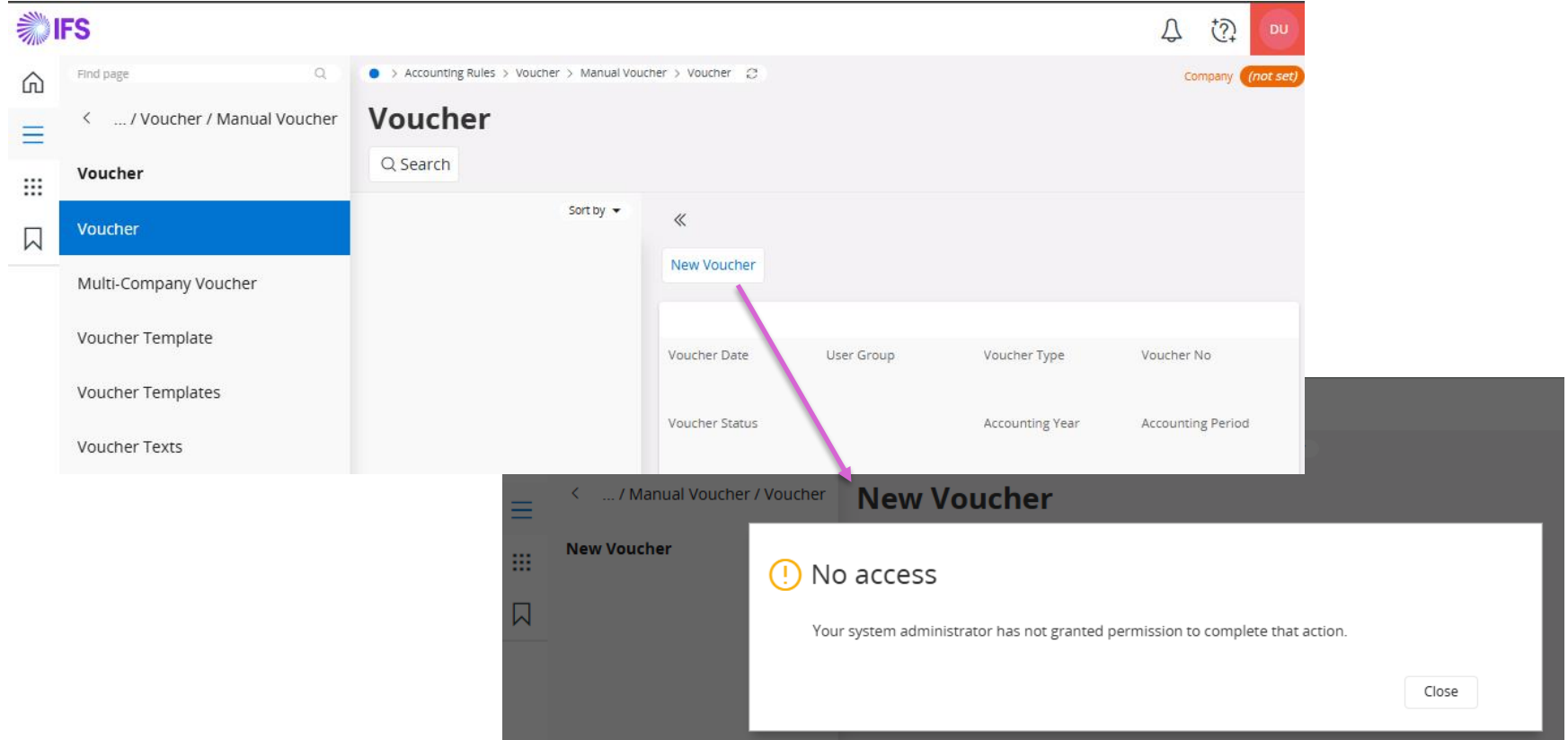
- Thorough testing before go-live is critical for identifying missing projections
- Alternatively, purchase predefined, tried and tested permission sets to reduce manual troubleshooting

Example

This permission set grants full access to everything under "Financials" and "Accounting Rules" via Manage by Navigator

## Limitation #6

Permissions are site-neutral

- IFS does not allow different permissions for the same user across different sites
- This is different from many other ERP systems, where user permissions can vary by site

## Solutions/Workarounds

- The simplest option is to accept this limitation and hope for future improvements
- Some customers, like Doppelmayr, use a workaround: creating separate IFS users for each site

# ERP Organisation

## ERP Organisation of the Group

ERP Team with around 20 people – split in Business Analysts and ERP Developers

The operational Business is divided into 10 areas - one or two Business Specialists (Super Key User) per area and regular Key User in other group locations.

### ERP Team

#### ERP Solution Management

IFS Business Analyst, focused on specific area

IFS IT & Admin and developers for modifications in IFS

### Operational Business Areas

IFS Business Specialist per area are single point of contact to ERP Team

IFS Key User in other group locations

Global IFS users

# ERP Organisation

## Environments and Modification Costs

Around 1000 Developer Days for modifications per year

=> **Very high effort for preparing and testing the changes**



# ERP Organisation

## IFS Tasks of the operational business

In the areas are installed

- Business Specialists
  - Employees of DM-Seilbahnen and DM-Garaventa
  - Single point of contact regarding the ERP Team
  - Responsible for First/Second-Level-Support worldwide
  - Responsible for testing the modification in the responding environment
  - Input of new requirements and developments

**=> Extended permissions in IFS are required and needed**
- Key-User
  - User in all other global locations
  - Contact person for Business Specialists

**=> No special permissions are needed for their daily business**

# User Management

# User Management

## Single-Point of Truth

- User Management and permission handling not in IFS
- External tool is in use for permissions and user management (User Life Cycle) and user configurations
  - Configurations – basic data and master data (Coordinator, Buyer, Default Site, ...)
  - External tool creates a script to execute in IFS
  - E-Roles and F-Roles get managed
  - Read / Write and Revoke definitions get managed
- Different permissions and configurations per environment and User is possible to handle
  - Different permissions sets per user in different environments
- Relation of User – Permission – Configuration – User Groups are visualised

# IFS Special User

## Definition of Special User

- Special Users are created for ERP Team and Business Specialists → not or only selected Key Users
- Special Users are also used for Interfaces into IFS
- Special User are configured for the specific usage → Special Users can also be created as IFS Employee
- One IFS Person can reference to several IFS Users
- Special Users are not part of the daily business



# IFS Special User

## Background and Reasons for Special User

- Business Specialists are responsible for global support and modification testing
  - Extended permissions are required
  - Access to all companies are required
- Interfaces use also Special Users or System Users
  - Extended permissions are required
  - Access to all companies are required
- All activities, done with Special Users are saved in History Logs and Transactions

# IFS Special User

## Consequences of Special User

- Special User has to be licensed as a regular user → higher costs
- Doppelmayr uses an Enterprise Licence → is helpful
- Special User can be handled as regular user of the regular user management
- Special User helps also for audits and report → Special User = Special Permissions
